



SPRUCE GROVE FISH & GAME ASSOCIATION EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE OF EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

To encourage qualified students to enroll into a career in the Renewable Resource, Environmental, Wildlife/Fisheries or Conservation programs at an accredited post-secondary institution. This scholarship will help to achieve the objectives of the Spruce Grove Fish and Game Association, as well as increase awareness and membership.

AMOUNT OF ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

The annual education scholarship is \$500.00 and will be awarded to a maximum of two successful applicants upon written proof in a letter by the post-secondary institution's Registrar showing the enrollment of the participants in the aforementioned programs.

CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

The conditions of this scholarship will include:

1. The student must be enrolled in either a Renewable Resource, Environmental, Wildlife/Fisheries or Conservation minimum one-year program at an accredited post-secondary institution.
2. Applicants should reside in the Tri-Region area which includes Stony Plain, Spruce Grove and Parkland County (preferred).
3. The interested applicant should have attended high school in the Tri-Region area for a minimum of one full year.
4. The applicant must meet the entrance requirements for the identified chosen field of interest.
5. The successful applicant can only be awarded the scholarship once and unsuccessful applicants may re-apply in future years.
6. Should the applicant receive other similar awards, they will not be disqualified from receiving this particular education scholarship.



TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

The terms of the scholarship will be:

1. The annual deadline for the application is September 30th.

3. The applicant is required to:
 - i) Use the Spruce Grove Fish & Game Application form.
 - ii) Submit transcript of high school grades and any other educational documentation as required with the application form.
 - iii) Submit a confirmation of registration from the Registrar of the accredited program at the post-secondary institution.
 - iv) Provide two professional letters of reference.
 - v) Include a resume.

4. ONLY the successful applicant for the scholarship will be notified by October 31st.

5. Payment will be made by cheque to the successful scholarship candidate.
